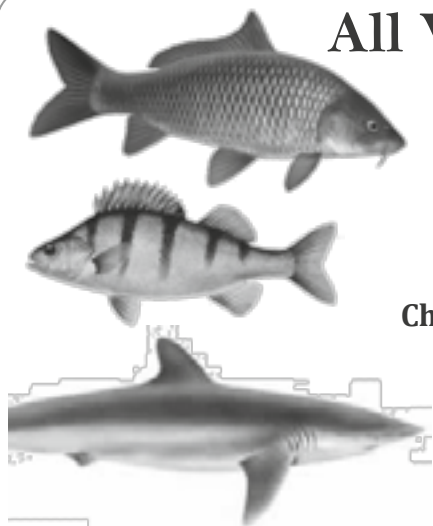

Financial Overview of Club

All shipshape aboard the HMAS GFCSA as usual.

Other than day to day running costs, the Club has no financial liabilities.

Year to date receipts total more than \$60,000 with advertising and sponsorship revenues accounting for more than half the total and membership fees making up the bulk of the remainder. Expenses for the same period total over \$35,000 leaving a healthy surplus of almost \$25,000 as of the end of January 2017.

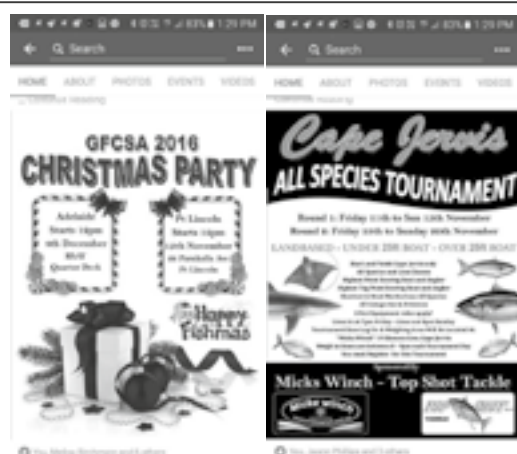

Broadbill on the hunt!

There are probably few things anglers find more frustrating than encountering significant numbers of fish that are just not interested in feeding.

In this case, it was a school of tuna milling around on the surface, the flash of their silver flanks adding to the visual excitement as they rolled over in the swell. Even the usually frantic sea birds knew they were not feeding and showed little interest.

Such was the situation on a recent visit to the usually-productive Cabbage Patch, south of Port Lincoln, by Broadbill and her crew, consisting of Rolf Czabayski, Graham Bald, Scott Sinclair and Nigel Hunt in early January.

Despite several hours of trolling, Broadbill managed to entice just one small tuna to grab a lure that afternoon. A 12kg samson fish was an unexpected bonus – as was the sight of 50 of his mates who followed him to the boat. In comparison to the wily tuna, the samson's were fired up with several attempting to snatch the bibbed Rapala from the mouth of the hooked fish boatside.

Broadbill was at the Cabbage Patch after her initial destination – Suzanne Shoal south-east of Wedge Island – was scrubbed from the itinerary after a near disaster on board. It was early on day two of the week-long trip. We were pulling the anchor at Wedge Island to head out to Suzanne Shoal and Scott was flicking the hung-up chain off the anchor brace when it unexpectedly tightened – squashing his right forefinger for a few seconds. It was enough to strip the skin from the tip of the finger, including the entire nail bed. A quick trip back to Port Lincoln and a visit to the hospital was required.

After revising our plans, later that day Broadbill was at Black Rock off Thistle Island chasing a few more whiting, before spending the night sheltering behind Taylor's Island.

With an encouraging forecast, the next morning would see a leisurely troll out to the Cabbage Patch, hopefully to find the tuna. Just on sunset Ron Forster's Longshot dropped in on her way back to Port Lincoln, having found both tuna and nannygai at the Patch that day. Little did we know the tuna would be uncooperative the following day.

After a relatively calm night in the anchorage of William's Island following the unsuccessful sortie to the Cabbage Patch, it was decided to troll to Low Rocks and then venture further south to several lumps south-west of South Neptune Island. Despite the water temperature nudging 20 degrees, there were no tuna schools at Low Rocks.

Rather than charge south, we opted to troll to the next location, hoping to come across a mobile patch of fish, but this never arose. Our spirits were further dampened when the lumps south-west of the Neptunes' also failed to yield a single tuna despite the ideal conditions. Things were starting to look grim.



After a brief discussion it was decided to troll east towards South Neptune Island and spend the night in the anchorage there, rather than travel back to William's Island for the night. In glassy conditions with a relatively low swell, Rolf took Broadbill within 20 metres of the southern side of South Neptune to see what might be lurking beneath the white water.

The scream of the ratchet snapped everyone into action and within a minute the smallest bluefin imaginable was lifted over the side. At 30cm, it was almost cute. A second fish not much bigger followed and then the kingfish moved in. While most were in the 2kg size range, we managed several to 5kg and quit when there were enough for a fresh feed and a few to take home in the kill tank.

With the sun low in the western sky, Rolf pointed Broadbill toward the south-eastern corner of the island to anchor up for the night and re-assess our tactics for the next day. We never made it. We had just caught sight of a large school of tuna sitting just off the corner when two of the four rods screamed out. Both were tuna in the 20kg size range that were soon on ice.

We had not been trolling for more than a minute when there was another multiple hook-up. The largest was a 32kg fish I managed. For the next two hours we managed around 20 fish in perfect, glassy conditions. Apart from a few larger models, the majority were tagged and released.

The sight of several schools of tuna feeding on the surface just metres from Broadbill was nothing short of exhilarating. There were literally tonnes of fish visible in the deep blue, almost purple water as they swam under the boat.

The anchorage at South Neptune Island may be fine in anything blowing from the south-east around to the south-west, but when a stiff north-easter comes up is anything but pleasant. When we turned in that night there was just a few knots of south-easter. By sunrise it had swung around to the north-east and was blowing around 20 knots. The morning forecast told us it would drop out by mid-morning before swinging around hard south-westerly as a thundery storm front rolled in.

A quick breakfast saw the anchor being pulled and plans made for a few hours trolling before heading for the mainland to shelter that night. We had only travelled a hundred metres from the anchorage when the familiar scream of "fish on" came from the cockpit. The tuna were right where we left them the previous night and just as keen take a lure. Once again, several larger fish were kept and another dozen or so tagged before we called it a day and headed for Taylor's Island in almost glassy conditions.

We had been anchored at Taylor's for perhaps an hour when the updated weather forecast came over the sked. Things had worsened with strong south-westerlies forecast to roll in by midnight. Rather than face shifting to find shelter in darkness later that night, we opted to head for home and enjoyed a few cold beers and a Bacardi en-route to Lincoln Cove in glassy conditions – the calm before the storm.

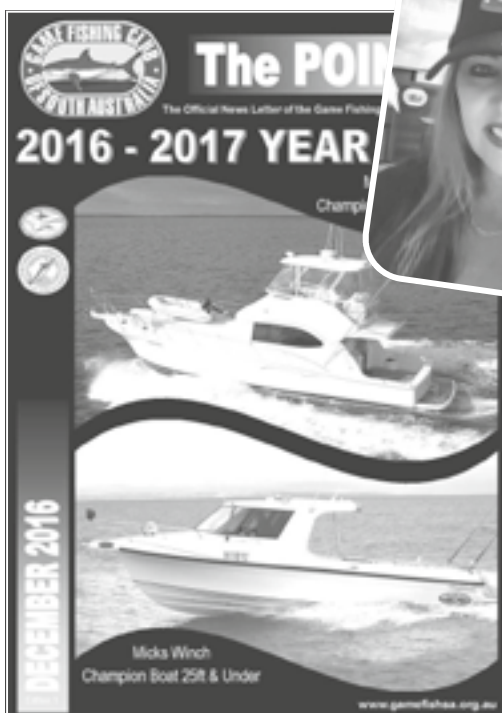

IGFA CHANGES TO ANGLING RULES

The IGFA's Board of Trustees recently met for their annual meeting where they ratified several significant changes to the IGFA's International Angling Rules and World Record Requirements.

Assisting The Angler

Current IGFA International Angling Rules state that "the act of a person other than the angler touching the rod, reel, or line either bodily or with a device once the fish strikes or takes the bait constitutes a disqualification. However, nowhere in the IGFA rules do we discuss the legality of another person touching or making contact with the angler. The IGFA is frequently questioned on the legality of touching the angler while they are fighting the fish.

In order to clarify this important subject, the IGFA will be adding the following language to the Section 3 of **Disqualifying Acts**: "Holding or touching an angler in a manner that assists them in fighting the fish or taking pressure of the angler. Touching or briefly holding the angler to prevent them from falling does not constitute a disqualification". This Change is effective April 1st 2017

Backing and Top-Shot

Current IGFA International Angling Rules state: "If the fishing line is attached to backing, the catch shall be classified under the heavier of the lines".

This rule has long been contested in cases where the main line or Top Shot is lighter than the underlying backing, as logic dictates that the lighter line will break before the heavier backing. This is also contrary to IGFA Angling Rules for Fly Fishing where the catch is categorized based on the breaking strength of the class tippet, which must be a minimum of 15 inches.

To address this issue, IGFA will be making the following alterations to **Equipment Regulation A**:

Title change from "LINE" to "LINE & BACKING"

Adding a new subsection that reads: "3. The use of backing is permissible"

Adding a new subsection that reads: "4. The catch shall be classified under the breaking strength of the first 16.5 feet (5 meters) of line directly preceding the double line, leader or hook. This section must be comprised of a single, homogenous piece of line"

This change is effective 1st April 2017

IGFA CHANGES TO WORLD RECORD REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Ratio Requirements

Currently, to submit a line class or tippet class (Fly rod) world record, the only weight requirement is that the fish must weigh at least .45kg (1lb). As a result, the IGFA has accumulated a significant amount of records where the weight of the fish is much lighter than the size of the tackle used to land the fish. In an effort to have IGFA world records better recognise outstanding achievement, the IGFA has established the following minimum ratio requirements for all new line class and tippet class world records:

For line class categories up to and including 10kg (20lb) and all tippet class (fly Rod) categories:

The weight of the catch must weigh at least $\frac{1}{2}$ as much as the line class it is eligible for. For example, a fish entered for the 6kg (12lb) line class or tippet class category must weigh a minimum of 3kg.

For line class categories greater than 10kg (20lb):

The weight of the catch must be equal to, or greater than the line class it is eligible for. For example, a fish entered in the 24kg (50lb) line class category must weigh a minimum of 24kg.

Minimum ratios will not be retroactive and records that currently do not meet the new minimum weight requirements will not be retired. Records listed in the 2017 World Record Book and IGFA website will have a new column that instructs anglers what the minimum weight necessary is to establish a record for each line class.

IGFA CHANGES TO RECOGNISED GAME FISH SPECIES

Eligible Game Fish Species

The IGFA maintains All-Tackle world records for thousands of different species, however only certain game fish species are eligible for the additional line class, tippet class (fly Rod), and Junior Angling world record categories. In an effort to better recognize premier game fish species around the world that merit having line classes, the IGFA will no longer be accepting line class, tippet class (fly rod), and junior Angler records on the 45 species of freshwater and saltwater fish listed below:

Freshwater: Rock Bass, Shoal Bass, White Bass, Yellow Bass, Bluegill, Black Bullhead, Brown Bullhead, Yellow Bullhead, Burbot, White Catfish, Black Crappie, White Crappie, Freshwater Drum, florida Gar, Shortnose Gar, Spotted Gar, Oscar, European Perch, White Perch, Yellow Perch, Chain Pickerral, red Piranha, Shorthead Redhorse, Silver Redhorse, Sauger, American Shad, Hickory Shad, Splake, Green Sunfish, Redbreast Sunfish, Redear Sunfish, Tench, Warmouth, Lake Whitefish, Mountain Whitefish and Round Whitefish.

Saltwater: Pacific Barracuda, Black Seabass, Japanese Parrotperch, Spotted Parrotperch, Florida Pompano, Doublespotted Queenfish, Black-blue Rockfish, Atlantic Spadefish and Oxeye Tarpon.

This change is effective February 1st 2017
