



Year to date receipts total more than \$17,000 at the end of August 2017 mainly from Membership Fees and the Marina Berth rent. Expenses for the same period total over \$8,000 leaving a healthy surplus of over \$9,000.

Outstanding membership dues totalling about \$4,000 will be pursued over the coming weeks. In addition, the Club will soon send out advertising and sponsorship invoices for The Pointer and for tournament shirt sleeves. Work has commenced on the new clubrooms and this will shortly impact the financials.

Can we catch Tuna in the winter? Portland and Port McDonnell both have a winter Tuna fishery.

Big barrels 100kg sounds good But along way from Adelaide. Robe is our chosen destination. Good marina and shelf only 28 miles offshore. We check Fish Track and hot water currents were running along the shelf. 12 degrees inshore and 16 outside, with a break in the weather and the promise of 10 knot winds for a few days we decided to give it a go.

We had a plan! Rolf is keen, excited even.

Leaving Adelaide at 6 pm we were anchored in Antichamber bay by 10am. It's beautiful and calm, at 4.30am we are up and off to Robe. We pass one of our Naval Frigates on sea trials looks impressive. 30ml out of Robe and along the 50 metre line we put the lures in. We are after a 100 kg barrel!


After 4 hrs of trolling nothing. We he'd in to Robe marina. We will have another go tomorrow.

We all enjoyed one of Rolfs beautiful Spag bolognaise. And the excellent facilities at the Marina. Lots of pro berths and council berths for visitors.

In the morning winds are still 10 knots as forecast, and the plan is to head out to deeper water near the shelf where the temperature is 16 degrees at 30 meters. We see bait fish on the sounder but no Tuna. Reaching 100 meters and 16 degrees we see our first Turns flying up high having a look at our lures.


This is a good sign! Then the action starts.

21 Tuna later we knew we had made the right decision. and our plan had worked. No big barrels, but lots of fish 9 to 12 kg. We never made it deeper than the 100 meter line so the hope is - the big barrels might be further out. A report comes in of a 101kg Tuna caught by Extreme charters at Pt Mac. Galaxy Star is staying in Robe for a while so maybe the big prize next trip.



Port Lincoln Trip With Spartacus - May 2017

This trip came about by a late minute discussion, but at the start of the week, the flights had been booked and we were getting ready for a weekend away with the boys! Dale, Northy and myself arrived on the Thursday evening and our first stop off was the bottle-o as we bought them out of Johnnie Walker, Bacardi and Super Dry. We headed down to the marina to prepare Spartacus ready for a rock star entrance from the man himself Ralph followed closely in tow by Ben G. There was excitement in the air on Friday morning as we did our final food shop and started our trek. Heading out into Boston bay, Spartacus had *AC/DC Back in Black blaring from the top deck letting everybody know we were in town*.

Our first day produced 34 SBF tuna, putting a nice gap in the yearly 25+ ft leader board between Spartacus and Broadbill. The conversations on the phone between Senior and Junior Czabayski could have been mistaken for a war time conversation with both parties speaking in code, Ralph trying not giving up too much information to Rolf!

On day two, the crew met over crumpets, all kept to a strict 2 crumpet ration to ensure our supply lasted, and decided to go on an adventure to new waters to see if the grass is really greener. Unfortunately the weather blew up with a 25kt westerly which hampered our efforts. We took refuge in a new anchorage which will now be known as **Eagle Ray Bay**. With 3 out of the 4 criteria already met for champion angler and champion boat, here enters Dale Smith. Dale's first hook up was on 10kg line class, but had the telling signs of a black ray. After 45 minutes of fighting, an executive decision was made to cut our losses and reload.

Dale changed to an 8kg outfit and within 5 minutes of baiting and setting the hook, we had a hook up. The fierce runs taken in the first 5 minutes was obvious that Dale had finally hooked what we had been seeking. After a short 20 minute fight in the rain we had landed an eagle ray. We all ran around frantically to weigh the ray, but to all our disappointment it fell short. 13.1kg. The tide was now nearing the bottom so we quickly baited up again. 3 minutes after, Dale had another hook up! The crew were on edge, "It's the same ray, surely it can't be another?" This ray was putting up a Herculean effort, taking 4-5 blistering runs, but after 35 minutes, we had landed it. Another Eagle Ray, but this one was bigger. We set up the scales, with the silence almost deafening as we waited for the scale to settle. 17.2kg, Dale had done it! The cheers were loud and there were high fives all around. This was my highlight of the weekend.





On the final day, the weather had given us some relief and we were able to start heading back towards Lincoln. A couple of hours into the trip, we came across massive bait balls and birds smashing the surface everywhere we looked. For a good two hours, we had multiple 4 people hook ups, with the crew ducking and weaving around each other to chase their fish. This turned out to be our highest points scoring day, landing 40+ fish. Ben Gerrits had a slow start to the day but got his groove back late to land a good number of fish and the biggest of the trip.

After cleaning Spartacus from top to bottom, we concluded our trip at the trusty Marina Hotel. The food prepared by Marty and his team was second to none as always. The trip ended in usual fashion with Ralph setting fire to another table with flaming Sambuca shots and Northy pumping his hard earned on max spins through Shogun. I had a great trip personally, taking part in my first proper fish as a part of the GFCSA and can't wait until the next adventure.

IGFA CHANGES TO ANGLING RULES

The IGFA's Board of Trustees recently met for their annual meeting where they ratified several significant changes to the IGFA's International Angling Rules and World Record Requirements.

Assisting The Angler

Current IGFA International Angling Rules state that "the act of a person other than the angler touching the rod, reel, or line either bodily or with a device once the fish strikes or takes the bait constitutes a disqualification. However, nowhere in the IGFA rules do we discuss the legality of another person touching or making contact with the angler. The IGFA is frequently questioned on the legality of touching the angler while they are fighting the fish.

In order to clarify this important subject, the IGFA will be adding the following language to the Section 3 of **Disqualifying Acts**: "Holding or touching an angler in a manner that assists them in fighting the fish or taking pressure of the angler. Touching or briefly holding the angler to prevent them from falling does not constitute a disqualification". This Change is effective April 1st 2017

Backing and Top-Shot

Current IGFA International Angling Rules state: "If the fishing line is attached to backing, the catch shall be classified under the heavier of the lines".

This rule has long been contested in cases where the main line or Top Shot is lighter than the underlying backing, as logic dictates that the lighter line will break before the heavier backing. This is also contrary to IGFA Angling Rules for Fly Fishing where the catch is categorized based on the breaking strength of the class tippet, which must be a minimum of 15 inches.

To address this issue, IGFA will be making the following alterations to **Equipment Regulation A**:

Title change from "LINE" to "LINE & BACKING"

Adding a new subsection that reads: "3. The use of backing is permissible"

Adding a new subsection that reads: "4. The catch shall be classified under the breaking strength of the first 16.5 feet (5 meters) of line directly/preceding ithengouble. Line, leaguer36r hook. This section must be comprised of a single, homogenous piece of line"

IGFA CHANGES TO WORLD RECORD REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Ratio Requirements

Currently, to submit a line class or tippet class (Fly rod) world record, the only weight requirement is that the fish must weigh at least .45kg (1lb). As a result, the IGFA has accumulated a significant amount of records where the weight of the fish is much lighter than the size of the tackle used to land the fish. In an effort to have IGFA world records better recognise outstanding achievement, the IGFA has established the following minimum ratio requirements for all new line class and tippet class world records:

For line class categories up to and including 10kg (20lb) and all tippet class (fly Rod) categories:

The weight of the catch must weigh at least ½ as much as the line class it is eligible for. For example, a fish entered for the 6kg (12lb) line class or tippet class category must weigh a minimum of 3kg.

For line class categories greater than 10kg (20lb):

The weight of the catch must be equal to, or greater than the line class it is eligible for. For example, a fish entered in the 24kg (50lb) line class category must weigh a minimum of 24kg.

Minimum ratios will not be retroactive and records that currently do not meet the new minimum weight requirements will not be retired. Records listed in the 2017 World Record Book and IGFA website will have a new column that instructs anglers what the minimum weight necessary is to establish a record for each line class.

This change is effective April 1st 2017

IGFA CHANGES TO RECOGNISED GAME FISH SPECIES

Eligible Game Fish Species

The IGFA maintains All-Tackle world records for thousands of different species, however only certain game fish species are eligible for the additional line class, tippet class (fly Rod), and Junior Angling world record categories. In an effort to better recognize premier game fish species around the world that merit having line classes, the IGFA will no longer be accepting line class, tippet class (fly rod), and junior Angler records on the 45 species of freshwater and saltwater fish listed below:

Freshwater: Rock Bass, Shoal Bass, White Bass, Yellow Bass, Bluegill, Black Bullhead, Brown Bullhead, Yellow Bullhead, Burbot, White Catfish, Black Crappie, White Crappie, Freshwater Drum, florida Gar, Shortnose Gar, Spotted Gar, Oscar, European Perch, White Perch, Yellow Perch, Chain Pickerral, red Piranha, Shorthead Redhorse, Silver Redhorse, Sauger, American Shad, Hickory Shad, Splake, Green Sunfish, Redbreast Sunfish, Redear Sunfish, Tench, Warmouth, Lake Whitefish, Mountain Whitefish and Round Whitefish.

Saltwater: Pacific Barracuda, Black Seabass, Japanese Parrotperch, Spotted Parrotperch, Florida Pompano, Doublespotted Queenfish, Black-blue Rockfish, Atlantic Spadefish and Oxeye Tarpon.

This change is effective February 1st 2017




