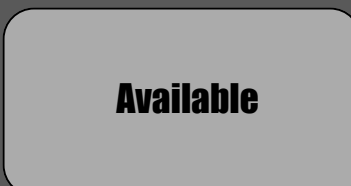

# In Honour of Clive Lewis Whitrow

Clive joined the Game Fishing Club of SA in 1953 and joined the committee in 1956, he was the honorary Secretary from 1966-1969 and became president in 1969 -'72. In 1981-1984 he took on the position of Weight Recorder. Clive was also the Secretary of the S.A. Game Fishing Association from 1981-1983 while John Johnston was the President. Ralph Parsons was the President of the Association from 1983-1985, Clive was the Vice President at the same time.

After this term with the association he was awarded life membership of the GFCSA in 1985 for his 32 years of service Clive contracted Searles Ship Builders of Port Adelaide to build a 24ft sail motor cruiser named after his wife, Sue Ellen. This sail motor cruiser was built out of jarrah and was designed to catch white sharks with a chair fitted at the stern. There's a photo of the chair in the G.F.C.S.A. clubrooms. Clive fished mainly out of Port Vincent on the Orontes Bank, where he caught most of his white sharks – 11 in total from his sail motor cruiser, the largest being 1700lb. Clive donated the jaws recently to the Club, which has decided to restore them to their original glory and mount.

The National Geographic Society made a documentary of shark fishing at Dangerous Reef, Port Lincoln. Clive took part in this documentary, along with actor and movie star, Fred Gwynne (from the popular TV sitcom, "The Munsters")

Clive also had a part in a second documentary with Fox Movietone, filmed at of Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island. The shark they filmed weighed about 1,200lb.

Clive fished with Club member and later Past President, Basil Mitchell, in a tournament at the Tuna Club of Tasmania. He also fished on other occasions with Bob Basto and Ern Palmer. Clive was very impressed with the tournament in Tasmania and, as he arrived home, planned and put into motion the first Kangaroo Island Tournament for G.F.C.S.A. members.

The Kangaroo Island Tournament was held in the month of April or May for one week. This Tournament is still alive 34 years later and continues to be held each year. Clive initiated committee dinners and then dinner functions for committee members and partners, many being held at the Naval and Military Rooms and various golf clubs

It has to be noted that Clive was the first angler to catch a southern bluefin tuna over 200lb at D'Estes Bay, along with Arthur Carolan, on the boat Aardvark. Later, Ralph Parsons caught a world record tuna on 50lb line.

In the '60s and before, only a few miles offshore from Glenelg, southern bluefin tuna were prolific. Clive used to go out with his daughter, Sue, after work and sail to the tuna schools. He caught a 26lb Tuna on 6lb line, which was an Australian Record

Clive crewed with Bill Coombs on Keith Waterman's boat, the 38 foot Southern Osprey, en route to Tangalooma, Queensland. Travelling day and night, they covered the 1,500 miles at seven knots. One night the autopilot misbehaved and took Southern Osprey many miles out to sea from Victoria.

When Clive awoke in the morning, he said "Where the hell are we? Australia is supposed to be on the left of us." They changed course and headed westerly until they reached Eden and then took the correct course again towards Tangalooma. The trip took approximately three weeks from Adelaide to Tangalooma. When they arrived in Tangalooma, they ran into Club member, Rolf Czabayski, and crew. Rolf had just purchased a 35f foot 'used' Bertram, which he was transporting by truck back to Adelaide from Brisbane.

On one of Clive's fishing trips off the Three Mile Beacon, Port Vincent, the propeller needed attention. As only the skipper would do, Clive put his arms in the water off the back of the boat to fix the problem. All of a sudden, behind the boat came an enormous white shark, which attacked the stern a few times. It was estimated to be 18 feet long and as round as a Holden car.

A few months later, when Clive's boat was on the slip, he pulled a shark tooth out of the stern that was in first class condition!

Clive still comes to some Club functions and enjoys life at the age of 90. Picture on the left showing Clive Holding the jaws of a 1700lb white shark he caught, now on display in the club rooms of the G.F.C. of S.A.





## TAKE NOTICE!

The Club would like all members, new and old to please make sure that they are aware of the clubs fishing rule changes regarding the heaviest & most meritorious categories of club trophies & the claiming of points.

To be eligible and in the running for these Categories your fish, shark or eagle ray must be weighed.

Also be aware that this year all angler divisions except Junior and small fries, intending on competing for Champion Angler in their respective categories are required to fore fill the four (4) main criteria of fishing, that has been till now, only required and applied to the senior men's divisions & categories those criteria are:- record the capture of a G.F.A.A. listed Shark, Game Fish and Eagle Ray and record the Tagging of a Game Fish.

## Notes : To all Club Members with Trailer Boats

## Financial Overview of Club

The GFCSA continues to be financially sound and well managed. The Clubs Liquid assets base total are still very high and we have just a couple of members still to pay their dues or resign from the Club.

Sponsorship donations include the third annual payment of \$5,000 from Peter Teakle for the 2017 Peter Teakle Port Lincoln Blue Water Classic, and the Club has attracted new sponsors and advertisers.

The Club maintains a healthy level of stock for sale to members at a fraction above cost price – current stock is in excess of \$24,000 at cost. There is over \$100,000 in depreciated assets owned by the Club in addition to various items of memorabilia held at the Clubhouse at Outer Harbor.

Other than day to day running costs, the Club has no financial liabilities.

Club receipts for the three months July to September 2016 total more than \$50,000 with advertising and sponsorship revenues accounting for more than half the total and membership fees making up the bulk of the remainder. Expenses for the same period total almost \$23,000 leaving a healthy surplus to carry the Club through the remainder of the financial year.

Greetings All,

We are once again at the beginning of a new season and one can only hope the 2016-17 season keeps up with the previous. This past season was an absolute cracker! The following statistics sum it up nicely:



**We had 1,623 Recordings, 19,662KGs of fish caught in all with 1,233 tagged fish making up an estimated 13,417KGs of that total so a lot of fish tagged where released for other lucky anglers to enjoy, astonishingly some 1,149 of those tags were dispensed into Southern Bluefin Tuna**

The top two, tag and release boats were **Majessnik** (717 SBT) & **Spartacus** (358 SBT)

Standout Tag and release Anglers included: **Russell Bianco** 313 Tuna Tagged, **Gabriella Gabbana** 222 Tuna Tagged, **Wayne Greenshields** 116 Tuna Tagged, **Ralph Czabayski** 88 Tuna Tagged, **Ashley North** 65 Tuna Tagged, **Kym Kessner** 50 Tuna Tagged, and **Dale Smith** 39 Tuna Tagged

## Local Waters (SA) 18 Species Caught

This second instalment of the Top Shot Tackle series on Gaffs and how to use them focuses on the flying gaff — a commonly misused tool of the sportsfishing trade.

**W**hen it comes to landing a large gamefish, there are four simple but important areas that need to be considered.

Firstly, fish are aero-dynamic and generally weigh less in the water than they do in air. Secondly, they spend their entire lives trying to stay upright in the water. Thirdly, they do not come with handles. And finally, they tend to become a fairly erratic in behaviour when they are being pursued by a predator.

Taking these four main points into consideration, a gaff becomes a vital tool and allows us to handle and/or restrain our catch during the landing process. Therefore the gaff chosen must be appropriate for the size, weight, position (in relation to the boat), and movement of the fish.

#### SWINGING FREE

The flying gaff or 'flyer' derives its name from the fact that it can be detached from a pole, allowing the hook to swing or 'fly free' on a rope.

The flying gaff is simply a large hook with a rope attached, with the other end of the rope tied off onto a fixed point on the boat.

The gaff and rope is also attached to a pole through a method known as lacing. The gaff is delivered into the fish with this pole. Once the gaff has been set or driven home into the fish — in other words, the maximum penetration has been reached for the type of hook being used — the pole is removed, leaving only the gaff hook in the fish, which is still attached to the boat by the rope.

The flying gaff system is used often — however it is also quite common for it to be misused.

The correct use of flying gaff systems — and, for that matter, all gaff systems — has been poorly documented over the years. There has not been enough educational information published on the procedures involved when gaffing larger fish. The lack of technical information on this part of a fishing trip has led to incorrect gaffs

being used, which in turn has caused many things to go wrong at the back of the boat.

#### BACK TO BASICS

If you own a set of flying gaffs, there are some fundamental steps you'll need to address before you go to sea and use them. Most of this is

just common sense, and can be practised on your boat while still at the dock.

Firstly, we need to ascertain some of the parameters for the gaffing operation — this mainly relates to the size of the boat being used and the anchor points you will be using to secure the rope. The most

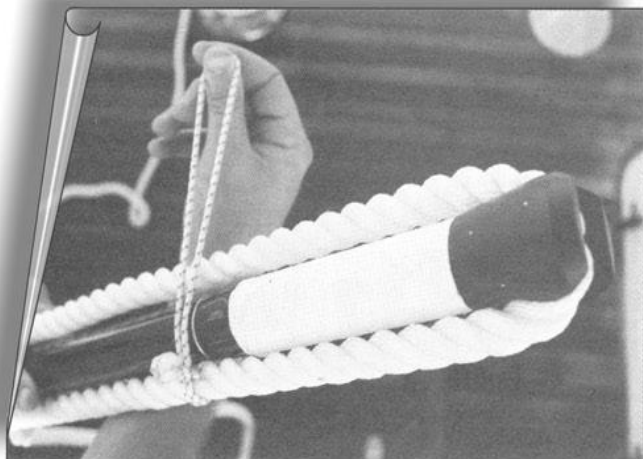

common anchor points are cockpit cleats or the gamechair post. Whatever anchor point you use, make sure it is a strong one — there is a lot of pressure on those anchor points when there is an angry gamefish on the other end.

Most pre-made flying gaff ropes are sold as a 25ft length. IGFA rules, however, do allow you to use rope up to 30ft in length. These rules indicate a maximum length but realistically 30ft is too long in most applications. Particularly stand-up fishing that smaller boats are now getting into.

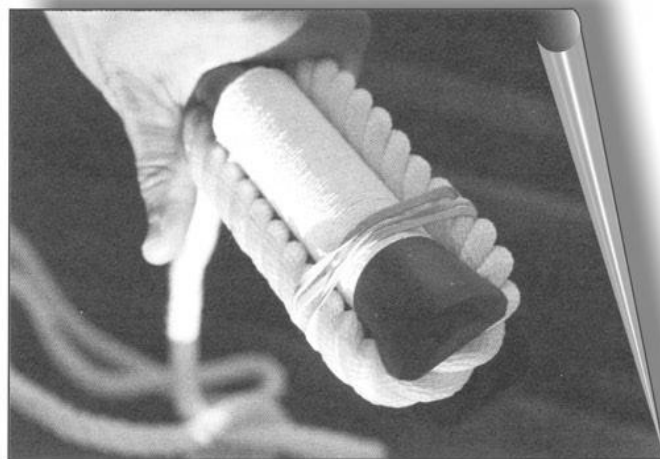
Most anglers have been led to

There are anglers who prefer to use ropes that are 25ft-long and include 2ft of heavy multi-strand cable. The cable is spliced on the rope at the hook end and attached to the hook. This set-up is used mainly by shark fishers to prevent their catch from biting through the rope if it turns back on it for a chomp — as they tend to do!

Lacing up the flying gaff should be done in the following way:

Attach the flying gaff hook head to the rope with the use of a 'D' shackle. Now slot the hook spigot into the spigot slot on the pole.

Pre stretch the rope back up along

point that you will use. Don't hesitate to cut the rope down if it is too long.

This formula will give you just the right amount of manoeuvring room when you gaff a fish, but not so much that the fish ends up too far from the boat to insert another gaff or to use a tail rope. A rope that is too long can spell disaster.

### THE EASY PART

You need to gaff as soon as possible before the fish senses the boat. Once the flying gaff is presented over the fish into the strike zone, it is important to lean or draw it back towards the boat to find the fish with the point of the gaff hook.

The fish will react at this time. As it does, you should hang back on to the pole and rope for as long as you can. This will help set or drive the hook home.

Generally you will reach a point where you can no longer hang onto the pole and rope, as you are drawn

forwards over the gunwale. It will be either pulled from your hands or you will just allow your grip to loosen enough so the pole and rope will slide through your hands.

At this point, the pole should automatically disengage from the hook, leaving you holding the rope — which you should also allow to feed through your hands until it comes tight to the anchor point. Don't just let the whole thing go and expect it to work all on its own.

If you have prepared everything as described above, you should have successfully gaffed your fish. The remainder of the exercise is fairly straight forward. To restrain the fish, it is just a matter of a short pull on the rope to position it so you can attach your tail rope, or use another gaff if required.

At this point the crew have completed the job without mishap — and most importantly, they have been in total control throughout the whole gaffing process.

believe that the pre-made 25ft length is the correct length to be used. But the truth is this that length has only become an industry standard in today's market, as they are mainly used on a large gameboats fitted with a gamechair, and does not really apply to smaller boats.

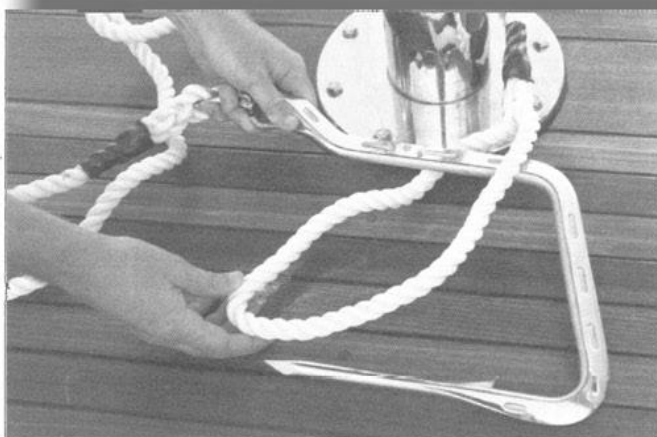
### ENOUGH ROPE

Some flyer ropes consist of just 25ft of rope with a spliced loop at each end. One small loop takes the 'D' shackle, and one large loop on the other end fits easily around the cleat, or chair post, to pass the flyer hook through.

the pole, placing the rope in the rope slot and then down the opposite side of the pole.

Using a bungee cord or heavy-duty rubber band, hitch around both ropes and the pole about six inches from the end.

Once you have laced up the flyer, it is possible to ascertain the correct length of gaff rope required for use in your boat. You should be aiming to keep the rope as short as possible, while still being manoeuvrable. The formula to use when measuring out the slack on the rope is twice the length of the pole (normally 6ft) plus the length of distance to the furthest anchor

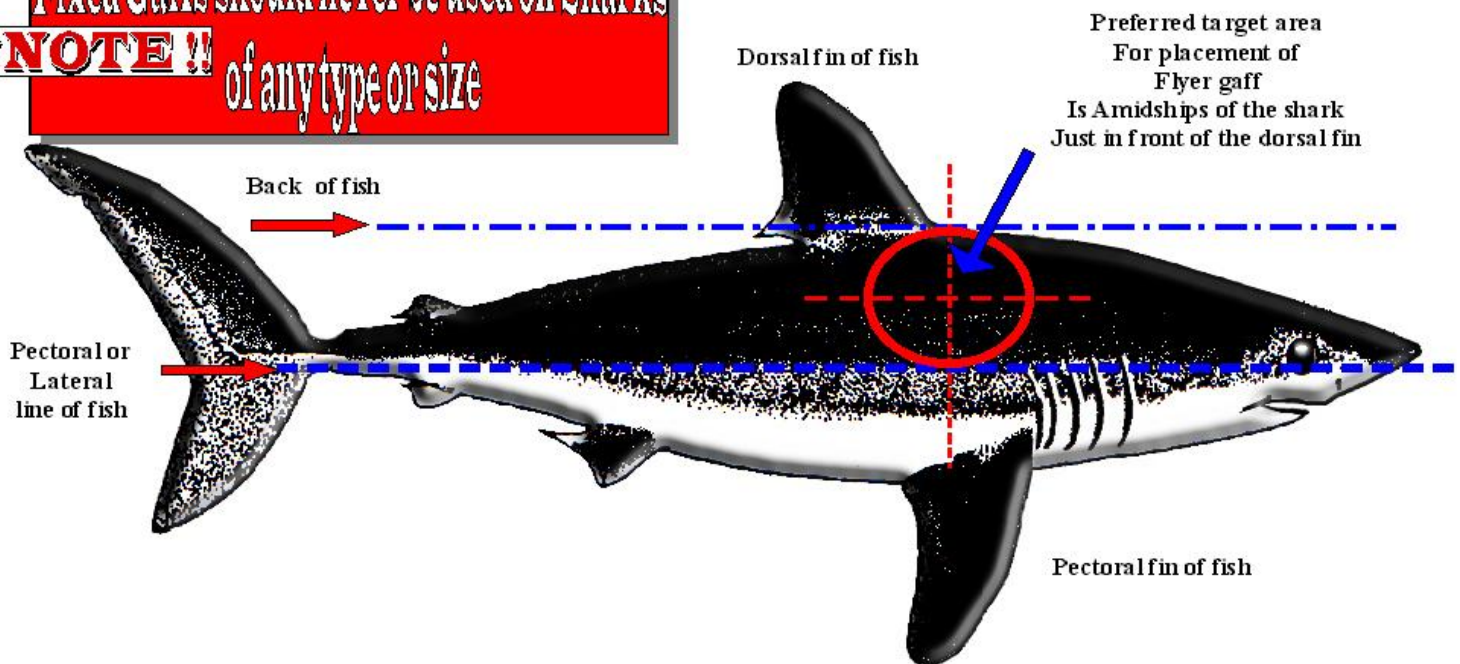


Above: Before you attach the flying gaff head to the pole, make sure the tail end of the rope is secured to an anchor point on the boat. The gamechair post is ideal.

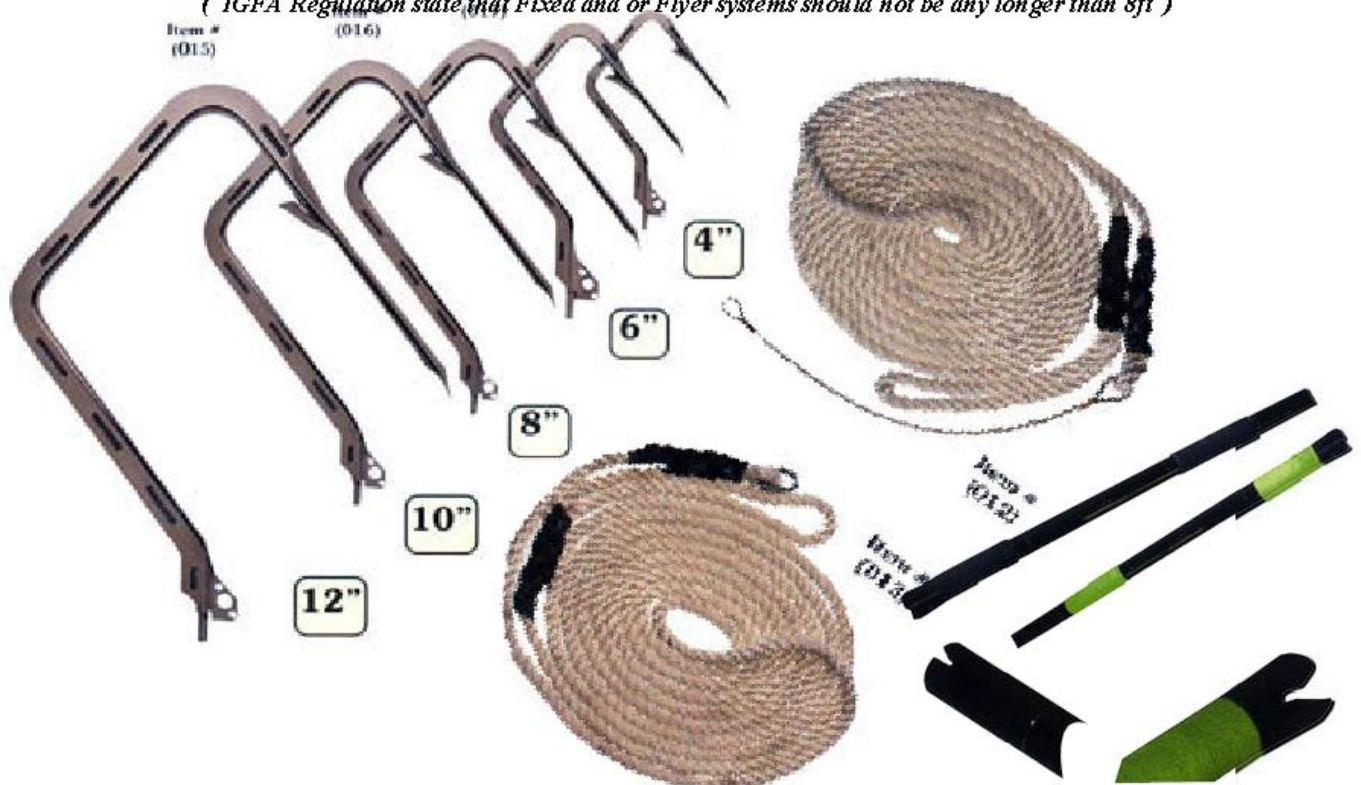

Then you halved it to give you the correct gaff head size to use for that fish, a 4 inch gaped gaff

( IGFA Regulation state that Fixed and or Flyer systems should not be any longer than 8ft )

Have you ever counted all the different species of Billfish you caught? You may be entitled to claim a Billfish Royal Slam, if not you may pursue to get the Billfish you haven't got.

I travelled all over the world to get the Billfish species I needed to get my Billfish Royal Slam.

If you need some information where to go, to get the Billfish you still need, give me a call.

For purposes of the IGFA Royal Slam Club's, a "Royal Slam" is defined as an individual angler catching, under IGFA rules, the required species for each club during his or her lifetime. All catches, past and present, are eligible as long as they have been caught in accordance with IGFA rules.

It is not necessary to kill the fish, and the IGFA encourages catch and release.

Photos of the Angler with the fish and the contact information of the captain and/or witness are required for all catches. Catches made after 1 January 2012.

**Each of the recognized clubs and the eligible species are listed below:**

**Billfish:-** Pacific Blue Marlin, Atlantic Blue Marlin, Pacific Sailfish, Atlantic Sailfish, Black Marlin, Striped Marlin, White Marlin, Spearfish and Swordfish  
(Nine Billfish in all if you have those you can claim your Royal Slam.)

**Tuna:-** Bigeye, Blackfin, Bluefin, Dogtooth, Longtail, Skipjack, Southern Bluefin and Yellowfin.

**Shark:-** Blacktip, Blue, Bull, Hammerhead, Mako, Porbeagle, Thresher, Tiger and Tope.

**Salmon:-** Atlantic, Chinook, Sockeye, Chum, Pink and Coho

**Trout:-** Brook, Brown, Bull, Catthroat, Golden, Lake and Rainbow

**Bass:-** Largemouth, Rock, Smallmouth, Striped, Spotted, Shoal, White and Whiterock.

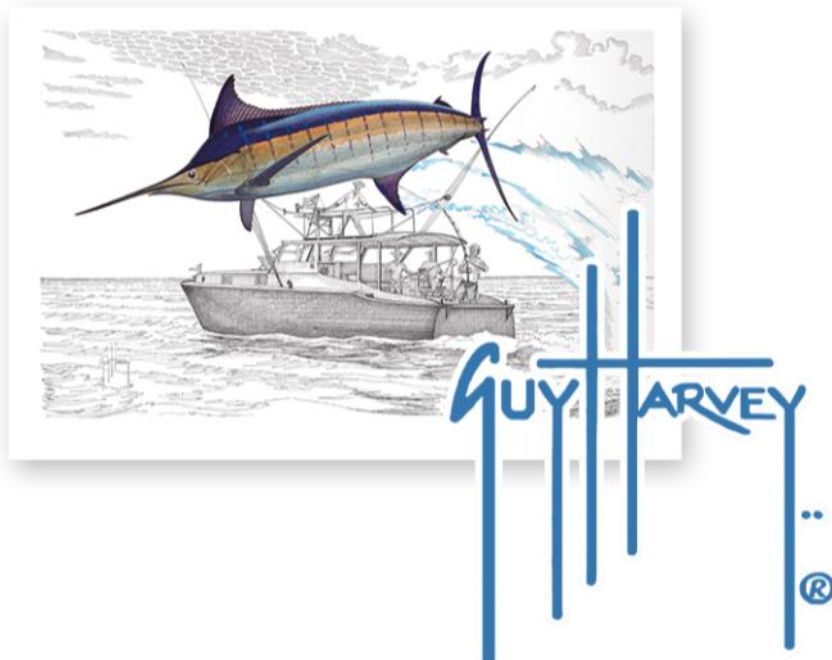

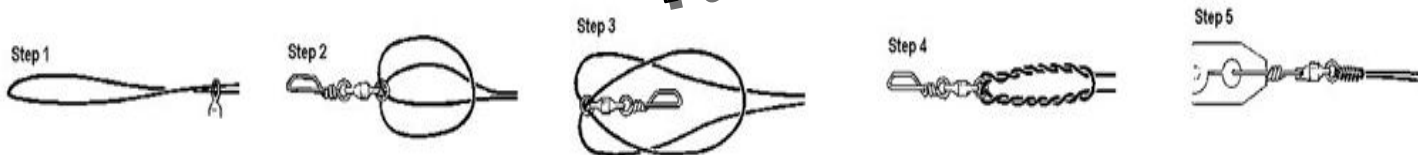

## MERIT PINS FOR CAPTURE

Merit Pins may be awarded to anglers for captures made in Australian waters and recorded in each of the various line classes according to the tables below.

GFAA shall design and control the issue of such Capture Merit Pins, which shall be engraved with the initials GFAA and be symbolic of the fish for which the award is made.

Club secretaries shall, by the authority of GFAA, order

and distribute Capture Merit Pins to club members who have submitted to them a written application supported by relevant Capture and Weight Recording Certificates.

State branches shall advise GFAA by July 15 each year the number and each type of Capture Merit Pins so distributed.

Only one Capture Merit Pin for each species and for each line class may be issued to any one angler during any one year ending June 30.

It is recommended that Capture Merit Pins be presented at club annual general meetings, presentation of trophy evenings, or similar occasions.

Note: the cost of the Capture Merit Pins shall be borne by the angler.

It is recommended that Tag and Release Merit Pins be presented at club annual general meetings, presentation nights, or similar occasions.

The cost of the Tag and Release Merit Pin

shall be borne by the angler.

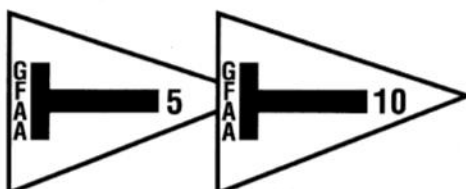

## CAPTURE MERIT AWARD 10 TO 1, 15 TO 1, 20 TO 1

A GFAA certificate is available for any recognised gamefish species.

To qualify for the certificate the angler must submit the following:

1. an Australian Record Claim Form stating the club the claim is submitted for, (eg 20 to 1)
2. a cheque for \$27.50 (inc. GST) for the issue of the certificate.

## 1000LB (454.4KG) CLUB

A GFAA award is available for any recognised gamefish species.

To qualify for the certificate the angler must submit the following:

1. an Australian Record Claim Form stating the claim is submitted for the 1000lb club
2. a cheque for \$110.00 (inc. GST) for the issue of the cap and framed certificate.

## TREVALLA, DEEP SEA

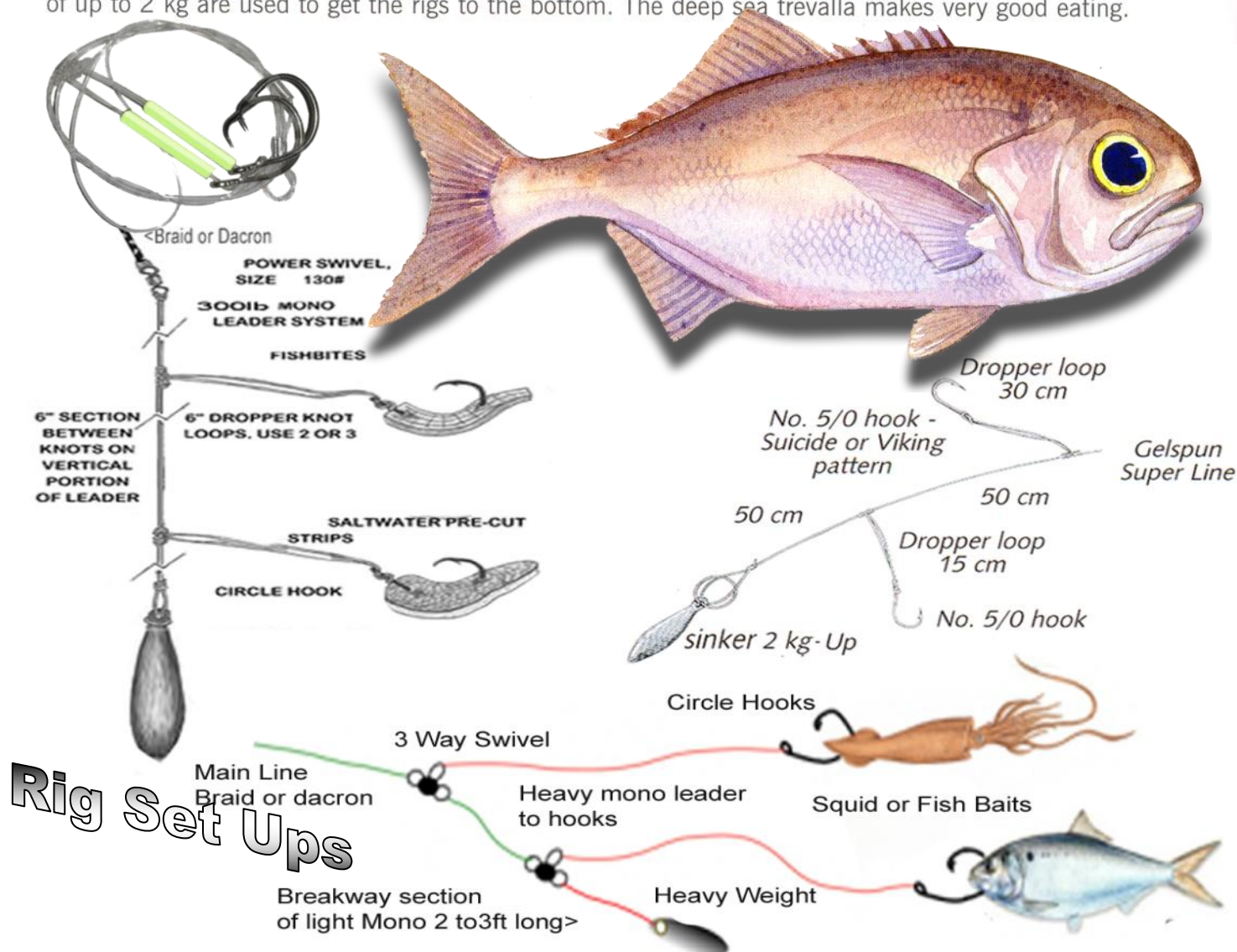
**Scientific name** *Hyperoglyphe antarctica*. Also known as Blue-eyed trevalla, blue eye cod, big eye, bluenose, medusa fish.



**Range** From central NSW southwards and including Tasmania as far west as near the South Australia Western Australia border.

**Description** The deep sea trevalla is a deeper water species which is taken in depths of up to 300 fathoms. It undergoes quite a dramatic change in form as it grows. Juveniles are often found associated with large jellyfish and have quite rounded fins which become angular, especially the tail of adults. Deep sea trevalla have a large deep blue eye with a golden ring. The large eye is typical of deeper predatory species. The mouth is large and this species is best separated from the similar but smaller warehou or the spotted trevalla (*Seriolella punctata*) by the more steeply sloping forehead and lack of spots in the deep sea trevalla. The deep sea trevalla reaches 1.4 metres and nearly 40 kilograms while the warehou grows to 76 cm and around 7 kilograms. The second dorsal of the deep sea trevalla is shorter and has 15 – 21 rays versus 25 or more for the other trevalla species.

**Fishing** Adult fish are found near the edge of the continental shelf or around deep sea mounts. A few are occasionally taken in waters of around 50 m when fishing for snapper or other deeper reef fish. A few dedicated specialists have been venturing out to the sea mounts off Wollongong and southern NSW to take bar cod, bass groper, hapuka and occasionally deep sea trevalla. However, there are very high fuel costs, a requirement for electric winches and no guarantee of a catch. Best baits are large cut baits on a multi-hook rig so that if a picker gets one bait there are other hooks because it is a long way up from the bottom. Weights of up to 2 kg are used to get the rigs to the bottom. The deep sea trevalla makes very good eating.
